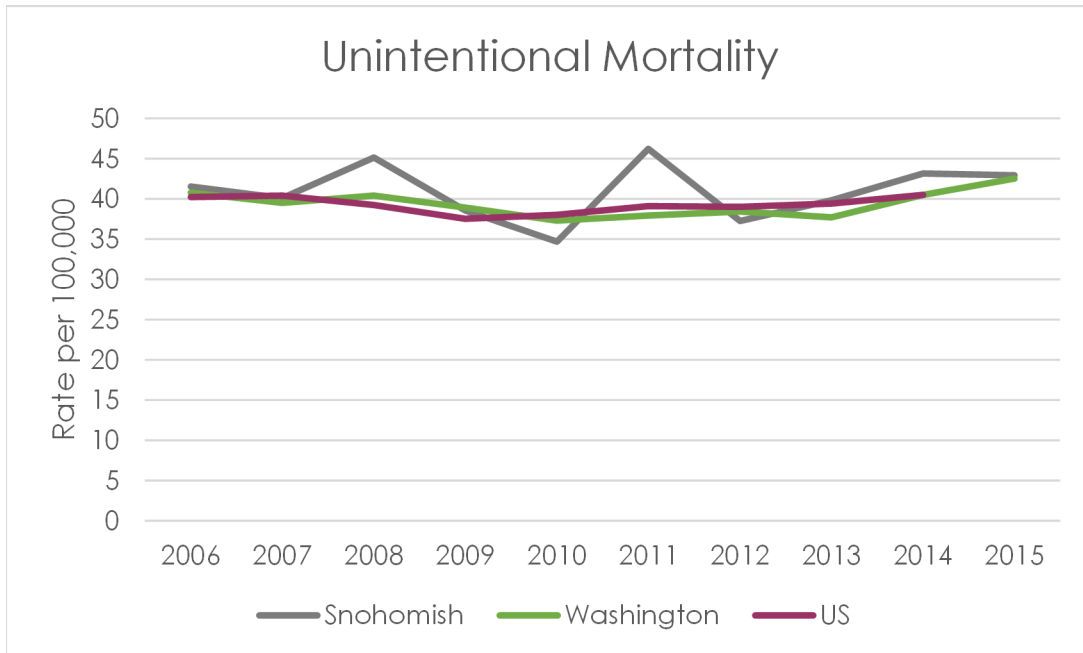




ACCIDENTAL DEATH
