



86% of 10<sup>th</sup> graders and 63% of 12<sup>th</sup> graders *report never having had sex*.

Percent of students who report they've never had sex\*



Among those who did have sex, *condoms* were the most common contraceptive method, followed by *birth control pills*, *then IUD or implant*. Only 4% of 10<sup>th</sup> graders and 6% of 12<sup>th</sup> graders reported using *no method* to prevent STDs or pregnancy when having sex.
